

Electrician tumbles from stage, fractures his ankles

\$350,000 settlement

The 38-year-old plaintiff employee, an electrician apprentice, was injured during the course of his employment on March 27, 2002, when he fell off of a stage and fractured both ankles.

The plaintiff was initially treated at Massachusetts General Hospital and subsequently by Dr. George Theodore. The plaintiff underwent several surgeries.

Prior to a scheduled hearing, both parties agreed to mediation.

Under the settlement, the plaintiff, who received Social Security disability insurance, received a substantial period of future Section 34 benefits.

A third-party case is pending.
